To The Musician

The following pages summarize where the various songs have been found in a number of selected books. The selection of songs for this booklet has been made for the purposes of group singing; however, as a musician you will find there are a lot of other good songs in these books. If you were to choose just one book, I would recommend the Tune Book from Songs & Creations, with The Other Song Book coming in second. For the number of songs in each (780+ & 250+, respectively), there is surprisingly little overlap.

The largest unique set of songs missing from those two books can be found in two or three of the other books (see the detailed listing that follows). The Glory & Praise book from NALR only has melody and words -- no chords, although NALR does have other publications with complete musical arrangements.

De Colores is found in the Walk to Emmaus Pilgrim's Guide, as well as in other Emmaus & Cursillo literature. The bold number in the listing indicate where a song is found only in that book (of those listed below); note also that some of the songs (8) are not in any of the books cross-referenced here. Two of those (The Chrysalis and Priesthood) are original songs, and the original musical arrangement is included.

Be sure to also note the list of copyright license holders that follows; use that list when seeking permission to use those songs for other purposes.
